

Speed Points Breakdown

This is just a quick explanation of the Speed Points and does not replace the Speed Point Rules.

Lead-Line: Little ones unable to ride alone. Must not exceed a trot.

Pee Wee: Little ones able to ride alone but may need direction to complete the pattern. Parents may be in the arena but may not lead or touch the horse or pony after rider crosses start/finish line to ride the pattern.

Youth: Children 13 and under. Advanced riders may compete in the OPEN class if they choose.

Open: Any age. Riders 13 or under may compete in Open class but riders must declare which class they will compete in for that year, Youth or Open.

The Open Class allows competitors to race against the clock instead of age group.

5D Time Breakdown		Example time	Includes times
1D	Fast Time	18.00	18.00 to 20.999
2D	Plus 3 seconds	21.00	21.00 to 23.999
3D	Plus 6 seconds	24.00	24.00 to 26.999
4D	Plus 9 seconds	27.00	27.00 to 29.999
5D	Plus 12 seconds	30.00	30.00 and over

Placing:	1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	6th	7th	8th	9th	10th
Earns Points:	10	9	8	7	6	5	4	3	2	1

Year-End awards are given by highest placing in any D (Division) so all points accumulated will count toward year end awards.

To qualify for the year-end High Point All Around award, you must compete in all four pattern classes, Pole Bending, Barrel Racing, Speed Pattern and Timed Trail.
